Criteria for Patients Needing Access Beyond a Peripheral Line

Criteria can be met by one or more of the below:

- 1. A) Need prolonged course of medicine required only via IV route, such as IV antibiotics. Transition to oral medications (like antibiotics) deemed not to be an option.
 - B) Difficult IV access (for any reason) with medical indication for medication(s) or fluids to be delivered by IV route.
- 2. Patients requiring hemodialysis or apheresis catheter placement.
